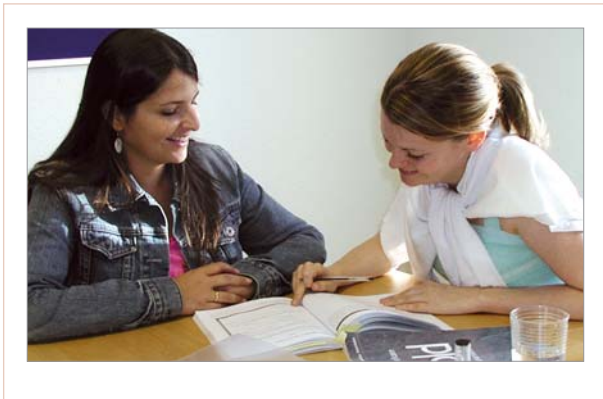

One-to-One (Individual) Tuition



This programme, which is available throughout the year, is aimed at students who need a more personal, individualised programme of study.

One of the main advantages of choosing this type of programme is that it allows students to make rapid progress within a relatively short period of time. Furthermore, it offers maximum flexibility in terms of length and duration and students can choose to concentrate on the skills (listening, speaking, reading, writing) and subject areas which they feel they really need to improve (General English, Business/Technical English, examination practice, etc.).

Lessons can be organised in the mornings, afternoons, or evenings. However, one-to-one programmes should be booked as far in advance as possible (at least one month's notice would be advisable), as the lessons have to be scheduled into our normal timetable.

At the beginning of the course, students' needs and objectives, as well as their strong and weak points are analysed by our teachers who then create an individual programme. The programme is discussed and approved by our Director of Studies. This means that students can study at their own speed without the distraction of other students who may be at a slightly different level or have different needs.

Apart from the formal study periods selected, students are assigned homework and are expected to spend some time on their own to consolidate work done during the lessons.

Booking Conditions for "One-to-One" Courses

- ☑ One-to-One programmes should normally be booked at least one month before the student wishes to start the course
- ☑ A minimum booking of 10 hours is needed for a course to be organised
- ☑ Tuition times and dates may be changed with one week's notice, and this is subject to availability of teaching staff and/or teaching rooms
- ☑ If a student cancels a lesson with less than 24 hours' warning, the lesson will be lost, i.e. it will not be rescheduled
- ☑ It is the student's responsibility to arrive on time for lessons. CELT will not extend the lesson if a student arrives late.



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
